ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Vein bearing N65°E, with varying dips close to vertical is hosted in a  
highly altered, iron-stained and bleached volcanic tuff. The vein is about  
2-3 feet thick with stringers of antimony within and along the contact.  
The vein is tracable along the surface for several hundred feet. Sample  
3100 was chipped from exposed portions of the vein and selected from dumps  
Since the mining for antimony the area has been cut by roads some of which  
was for drilling.
