DEVELOPMENT: Workings consist of 700 foot of trenches and open-cuts and three shallow shafts.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLGY: Locally the area is covered by rhyolite flows and tuffs intruded by silicified veins with pods and stringers of stibnite that carry minor silver values. The host rocks have been bleached white in places are strongly iron-stained and argillically altered. There is more than one vein with most ranging in thickness from 1" to 3 feet. The main vein system is tracable for more than a 1000 feet. Sample 3101 was from a vein that bears N80°W is silicified and contained visible bladed Sb, and red and yellow antimony oxides.
