DEVELOPMENT: Was reported to have worked from an incline shaft, serving eight levels to a total depth of 360 feet, with approximately 3 miles of laterals. Some good buildings remain and are being preserved by the park service.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: It is now a state park.

GEOLOGY: The mineralization occurs in quartz veins that have intruded Permian meta-volcanics.

REMARKS: A sample was collected selectively from several dumps next to the Berlin Mine.
