DEVELOPMENT: Four adits all caved and on fifty foot shaft.ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Older sediments capped by basalt have been intruded by fined grained granite or aplite. No visible mineralization except for minor copper. The sediments are a fine-grained sandstone. A 50 foot shaft on top of the hill was sunk on a 2-3 foot quartz vein. Sample 2959 is from that vein system and a fine grained granite host.

Sample 2958 is from a fifteen foot shaft to the west of the main activity that was sunk on a vein bearing N65E, 75NW. The vein is along a contact fault (?) between black shale and white fine-grained quartzite. The vein has some quartz along with a high percentage of gouge.
