DEVELOPMENT: Most of the older workings are either flooded are inaccessible and many have been dozed over by road and drill site building.ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Temporarily halted. This property is now consolidated with the Ashdown Mine to the south.

GEOLOGY: Triassic meta-sediments have been intruded by large masses of bull quartz from granitic sources which also outcrop within the area of the Vicksburg Site. Sample 2947 is from an aplite dike and brecciated vein north of the Vicksburg Site. The main area of the camp is a labyrinth of roads and drill sites by American Copper and Nickel, all within the last few years.
