LOCATION

Eagle Valley Mining District, Ormsby County, Nevada, about 4 miles northwest of Carson City.

GEOLOGY

Mineralized granite schist contact. The schist, a dark colored thick formation, has a northeast-southwest strike and dips approximately 35 degrees to the southeast. Locally the granite contains large bodies of pegmatized quartz and orthoclase. Considerable tourmaline is associated with the quartz. Mineralization follows fractures in the schist, roughly paralleling the bedding planes. The resultant veinlike sheet or zone of highly silicified schist is fairly regular and persistent though narrow. Chief gangue minerals in their order of prominence are epidote, garnet, and quartz. Sulphides are almost entirely absent. The scheelite occurs both as disseminated grains and in sporadic bunches throughout the mineralized zone.

DEVELOPMENT

Superficial development comprised of numerous surface cuts and shallow adits and shafts. Scheelite mineralization is low in grade, ranging from nil to 0.39% WOz over widths from 0.8 foot to 4 feet.
