GEOLOGY: Quartz vein 1m wide N 60°E, 50°SE dip. Minor pyrite, probably contains some Au. Several pits and trenches dug on vein. Adit in Mule Springs Limestone, disseminated galena and sphalerite present in marble. Garnet-pyroxene tactite present in same horizon further west. Very large zoned garnet, some copper oxide in tactite. Lamprophyre sill occurs on ridge crest. No obvious association with mineralization.
