GEOLOGY: Most of the claim area is underlain by a dull red, porphyritic, sanadine-rich volcanic (latite or decite) this material covers folded limestones which make up the core of the Leppy Hills, the SW flank of the range, extending out into the valley, is covered by Lake Bunneville sediments. The Wendover Queen claims cover mostly volcanics and lake sediments. The only sign of Host?work was faily new markings on some of the claim posts. No signs of mineralization were seen. No FeOx staining, no structure, no obvious reason for the claim location. The pits seen were in volcanics, (Su?) or lake dyrosite.
