The Harwood Prospect was mentioned under Conclusions in the report on The Grantelmyer Property, Hamilton, White Pine County, Nevada, and its location in the district is shown on the map which accompanies that report.

Since writing the above report a 25# sample of ore from the bottom of the winze below the tunnel level has been received. The ore is oxidized and similar to the sample taken by myself at the time of my visit to the prospect. The sample assayed as follows:
