DEVELOPMENT: 0.1 mile up canyon - adit trends N85°E, very extensive dump. Cu-oxide lying on dump & overhead @ portal entrance track is still in & ore dump facilities in good shape. No equipment around.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Surface geology is medium-light gray limestone with minor fracture, filled with calcite.

- REMARKS:
- 1) Drill hole up canyon from main working \approx 0.1 mile cap welded over hole casing - marked "PS, 01"
 - 2) 2nd drill hole in canyon east of above portal.
 - 3) Picture on camera. May not be a full frame. Looking east into mouth of above portal. Took second picture-RBJ #2 on camera. Slide #1.
 - 4) Sample #924 - from dump of above portal.
 - 5) Picture #2 on camera. Looking east from open bench into ore chute & dump of above workings.
 - 6) Claim Post - Name of McCall, Bustos, Sept. 1, 1980.
 - 7) Two small adits, both trend East & are on south side of canyon 300 feet down canyon from above workings.
 - 8) 3rd small adit trends east on south side of canyon about 200 feet after turning up this canyon off of main road.
 - 9) Oral communication, W.R. Wilson - 1500 ft. & drill hole on this property
