DEVELOPMENT: Caved adit (Location shown on topo map) And small open-pit in old mine dump.  
Probably muled down to leach pods in Hamilton.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Surface geology above adit &amp; also material lying on dump is a medium-light grey limestone. There is a minor oxidized zone located above mouth of adit which runs up hill from it. Assume adit follow this zone(?) A dark gray on fresh surface to buff colored on weathered surface, shale composed the east side of dump.

REMARKS: From size of dump adit must go in several hundred feet. Fair portion of dump has been mined &amp; probably been leached in Hamilton.
