DEVELOPMENT: Above & on West side of road - 1 adit partially caved trends N30°W. Remains of old ore bin below adit. Waste dump runs off to the S-SW

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Med-gray limestone with numerous small, discontinue with calcite veinlets. Cu oxidized visible on dump in front of adit. It appears to be in some type of silicified material (replaced limestone ?) #923 . 1) Minor amount gossanous material lying on ground at base of ore bin.

REMARKS: old cabin along west side of road up canyon from adit.

- 1) Sample # 923
- 2) Picture slide # 18 on camera. Base of ore bin, looking up towards old building & dump level on which adit is located. Adit take off to left of old building & in back of it.
- 3) 2nd adit at level of old dump on west side of road. Trends N25° W & is vertically below old ore bine & adit above it. Probably 100-125 feet difference in elevation between two adits very extensive dump in front of lower adit
- 4) Evidence of very recent surveying down Shermantown Canyon & at some of old workings in Canyon Surveying actually starts @ Belmont Hill & runs south.
