LOCATION OF PROPERTY

The mine is located in White Pine Mining District, White Pine County, Nevada, in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 25 T. 18 N., R. 27 E., Mt. Diablo B & M. The District is sometimes referred to as the Hamilton District. Mine lies along the canyon road between Hamilton and Shermantown; about 2 miles from former and 1 mile from the latter, at an elevation of about 8200 feet.

GEOLOGY

The Oro vein is an open-fracture type fissure vein in limestone formation. The vein contains much oxidized material in which segregations as patches, bunches and layers of silver-lead carbonates occur. For District geology see Lincoln references.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

Mine consists of 4 patented Lode Mining claims known as the Oro, West Onetha, Onetha contiguous, and Milwaukee, about 400 feet to north of contiguous group. Development work consists of crosscut tunnel 105 feet long drifts on adit level. 50 foot winze 300 feet of drifting on vein from bottom of winze.

ORE RESERVES

Limited, not promising as profitable operation.
