DEVELOPMENT: Open pits along fault, old adit.ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, some exploration including core drilling, approximately 10 years ago.

GEOLOGY: E-W to NE trending fault zones in gabbro, silicified lenses along fault to 1 m wide. Gabbro brecciated, silicified, pyritized and bleached along fault. Lenses contain pyrite, jamesonite and arsenopyrite(?). Jamesonite is largely altered to bindhemite. Relict pods of sulfide surrounded by oxides. Most of ore mined must have been oxide.
