DEVELOPMENT: None other than recent work on part of the road and the two short adits shown on the topo sheet. Small dumps. Portals caved.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None. The property is about 500m southeast of the Wadley Mine. Ro-Mac is placering below the Wadley in the canyon.

GEOLOGY: The workings are in gray phyllite of the Ordovician Valmy Formation. A few spotty occurrences of vein quartz are on the dump. These were sampled. The wallrock immediately adjacent to the vein matter is bleached; iron-stained rock is more extensive.

The more extensive workings at the Wadley Mine are not accessible, because of a locked gate at the Ro-Mac placer operation.

REMARKS: Sample 2356 is of select rare quartz vein matter from the small dumps.
