GEOLOGY: Shales and sandstones have been cut by northwest trending shears that contain quartz veins in varying widths and gangue materials with iron oxides containing small amounts of gold according to Wilden 1985. This part of the district is scarred by numerous dozer-cut made while exploring for shear and veins. In addition, there are numerous adits and several large shafts none of which are accessible. Most of the workings are old and not timbered. The same type of exploration is apparent along the southeast portion of the Winnemucca Mtn in an exposed diorite. Sample 2376 was taken from a caved adit and dump below a major shaft in the diorite. Minor tungsten shows were seen in the sample when it was lamped at the laboratory.
