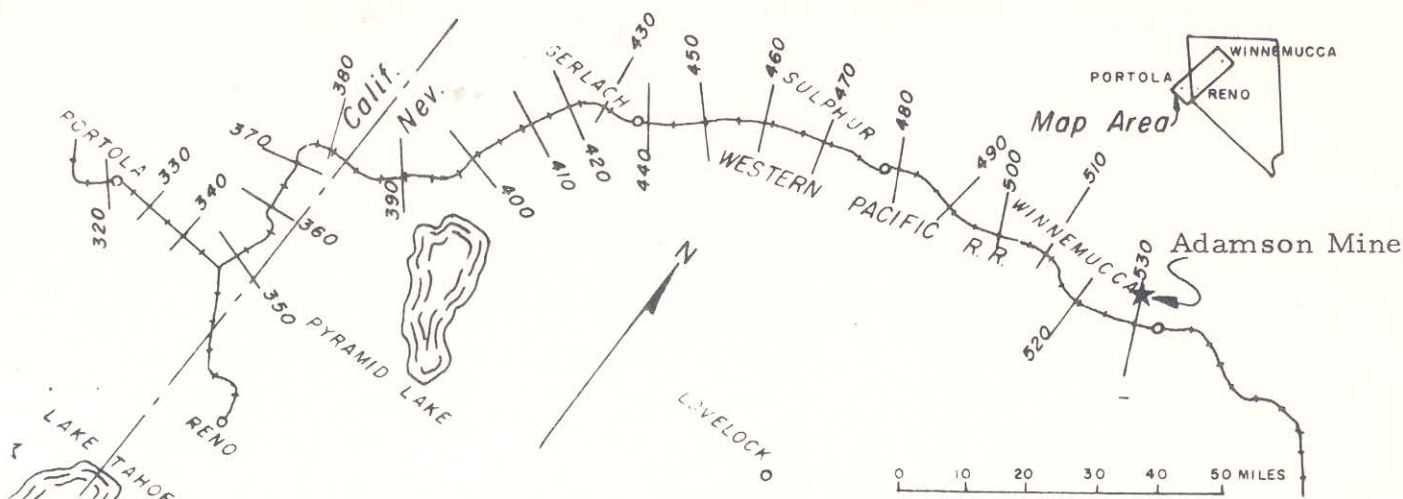

**DESCRIPTION:** On east side Winnemucca Mt. Exploited prior to 1911 and yielded gold ore valued at \$8,000.00. The production came from a vein which strikes NE and dips NW. In the SW part of the vein filling is calcite with local cinnabar; in the NE part the filling is quartz, barite and gold. The gold was found in drusy quartz. Past production \$8,000.00 gold. Presumably mined out.
